What have we been doing this past week?

Reading

For the next number of weeks we will be teaching new words by sight — this is where your child is shown the word on a flashcard and they try to remember the shape of the word and what it says.

New words for this week - a and red

What can you do to help?

Write/print out these words on small pieces of paper/card which will fit into a small container (e.g. butter tub, snack container). Home Bargains are selling these at present (79p for 3 tubs — this will be handy as you will need another separate tub when we start to learn Jolly Phonics)........... We are not on commission ©

Each day go over these words with your child.

Fine motor skills

Scissor skills — hopefully you have seen the pages we worked on this week — cutting straight lines. We would encourage you to reinforce this at home. In school we talk about "thumbs up" when holding our scissors and "opening/closing the crocodile's mouth"

Numeracy

Shapes – we have been looking at squares, rectangles, triangles and circles. See how many you can find around the house or when you're out and about.

Counting - forwards and backwards to 10

Homework

Handwriting skills – straight lines

Monday - pages 1 and 2

Tuesday - page 3

Wednesday - page 4

Thursday - page 5

Friday — return the book to school.....we will not be taking these out of schoolbags before this

Ensure your child:

works from left to right and top to bottom

puts pressure on the page

does not hold their pencil in a fisted grip

please bear in mind these are pre-writing skills and still developing
