Fine motor skills

Scissor skills – continuing on with cutting straight lines to a point.

Pencil grip — tracing over our first name. In school we ensure the pencil is held correctly and pressure is put on the page. We use a capital letter ONLY at the start of our name. If you are practising this at home, please discourage capitals in the middle of names -
